

Consent to Install Just Checking

Just Checking provides activity monitoring services that help care professionals complete objective, evidence-based assessments.

The Just Checking system is a series of discreet door, movement and activity sensors around an individual's home that provide an overview of daily activity to help professionals make proportionate care decisions. A 24-hour, objective overview of an individual's activity at home, in conjunction with other information gathering, enables practitioners to establish a realistic picture of the care required.

Using Just Checking gives a better understanding of when support is needed and puts the focus on maximising independence and autonomy without compromising quality of care.

Benefits to a person

- Objective review of needs
- Non intrusive means to assess no cameras or microphones
- Provides users with communication difficulties a way to demonstrate their capabilities

Consent questions

The following questions overleaf may help to indicate that a person understands and can consent to an installation of Just Checking. If it is clear that the person is unable to consider this information fully and communicate their decision, the information can form the basis of an assessment of capacity and decision in best interest:

- ✓ I understand that Just Checking uses sensors to pick up movement around my home
- I understand that Just Checking has been asked to assess my activity at home by my Council/HSCP
- ✓ I understand that this will involve placing sensors around my home for 2-4 weeks
- I understand that these sensors are not cameras and they cannot see or hear me
- I understand that the sensors make a chart of activity that I, staff and other people who are involved in my support, can look at on a website
- I understand that this information will help to decide on how to support me in the future
- I understand that this data will be processed and stored in line with GDPR
